What is the format of this course?

- A case study is used during the course, allowing delegates to secure new skills.

What is the course assessment?

- Delegates will be required to complete a short multiple-choice test on the last day of the course
- 100% attendance is required on this EMS internal auditor course (per CQI and IRCA rules).
