ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Foundation Course ISMS

An entry-level, informative course designed for anyone new to ISO 27001:2022. This course provides delegates with an understanding of an Information Security Management System (ISMS) and the requirements of the ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Standard.

Who should attend this course?

- New auditors who wish to gain an understanding of an ISMS against ISO 27001:2022.
- Anyone who is implementing an ISO 27001:2022 Information Security Management System.
- People who are involved in planning or managing an ISMS.
- Existing auditors who need a refresher on ISO/IEC 27001 or need to update to the 2022 edition.
- Those looking to attend an ISO 27001:2022 Internal Auditor, ISO 27001:2022 Lead Auditor, or ISO 27001:2022 Auditor Conversion course but don't have the required prior knowledge.
- This course contributes to the development of personnel wishing to join the CQI or those wishing to register as an Auditor with IRCA (International Register of Certified Auditors).

What will delegates learn on this course?

- What is an Information Security Management System (ISMS)
- ISMS principles and terminology
- ISO 27000 family of Standards – ISO 27000, ISO 27001, ISO 27002, etc.
- Interpreting the requirements of the ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Standard
- The Process Approach
- The PDCA Cycle
- Risk management
- Continual Improvement

ISO/IEC 27001:2022 requires organisations to ensure that personnel are “competent on the basis of appropriate education, training, or experience”. This Foundation course provides delegates with essential knowledge of the Standard to enable organisations to manage their ISMS effectively.

What is the format of this course?

- Virtual and classroom courses combine tutor-led sessions and engaging activities to secure learning (approx. 25% theory and 75% practical).
- The Online version of this course consists of 11 training modules, which include lessons in the form of presentations, videos, animations, engaging activities, and quizzes. The bite-size modules are approx. 30 minutes each, so can easily be completed around other commitments. After booking the course, joining instructions are sent via email – these will include unique log-in details along with links to the Digital Learning Portal. Delegates have 30 days to complete the course, access ends upon completion.

What is the course assessment?

- Delegates attending a Virtual or Classroom course will be assessed on their participation and general performance during the course, including any interactive exercises and activities.
- Delegates learning via the Online course will have knowledge checks in the form of quizzes throughout the course.
- Delegates must attend 100% of the course (in accordance with CQI and IRCA requirements).
